It also helps us remember to not interrupt others. The kids will learn strategies for 'thinking' hurtful or inappropriate thoughts. The group will also learn how to wait nicely and not interrupt others. Activities will include group discussions, workbooks, games, and role playing. (*Other ages may be appropriate.
